The mission of the Spencerport Central School District is to "educate and inspire each student to love learning, pursue excellence and use knowledge, skills and attitudes to contribute respectfully and confidently to an ever-changing global community". As part of that mission, the Spencerport Nature Center (SNC) is an accessible instructional outdoor classroom that promotes environmental learning and stewardship. In its role as an oversight group for the SNC, The Nature Center committee would like to provide an environmental education opportunity for students of Spencerport through sponsorship for an environment camp experience.

The Spencerport Nature Center Committee is offering a full summer camp scholarship opportunity for one week for students aged 11 through 17. Per the NYSDEC summer camp rules, "Campers must be the minimum age by December 1 in the calendar year to attend camp." The camps are run by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC). NYS DEC camps combine environmental and sportsman education along with outdoor fun. DEC camps include hands-on methods to learn outdoor skills such as back-packing, camping and canoeing. Campers will explore diverse habitats, study stream life, solve challenges, and learn environmental concepts. Participants come away with an awareness of the importance of nature and of stewardship of our natural resources. Who is Eligible to Apply?

- Students currently enrolled in the Spencerport Central Schools district. Students completing 5th grade (age 11 by December 1) through age 17 are eligible.
- Meets age requirement guidelines as established by the DEC Environmental Camp Program.
- Applicants should have an interest in the outdoors and in learning more about our environment.

How do Interested Students Apply?

- Starting Monday, January 8th: Application packets can be found at your child's school counselor's office. Applications can also be found in the Virtual Backpack or by emailing cbowerman@spencerportschools.org.
- Applications must be submitted to school counselors' office by 4 p.m., Friday, January 26, 2024.

Applications will be reviewed by the Spencerport Nature Center Committee. Applicants may be interviewed as part of the process. Scholarship will be awarded in February. Students must complete the DEC Camp application process which starts early January. The Scholarship student, upon completion of attendance of camp, will be asked to submit to the Nature Center Committee a reflection of his/her camp experience that used skills of collaboration, communication, creativity and critical thinking.

If selected student is unable to attend, an alternate will be chosen. Scholarship awards are only applicable for the year awarded. Only one scholarship awarded per student.
